The Gospel of Luke that is proclaimed at the Easter Vigil is an account of the women discovering the empty tomb. Imagine their feelings of depression, loneliness, anger and fear. When life situations have us feeling like these women might have felt, we need only turn to scripture stories about Jesus' resurrection. (There are fourteen of them in the four Gospels.) That is where we find proof that despair and death do not win - that God is at work in the most hopeless of human situations.
