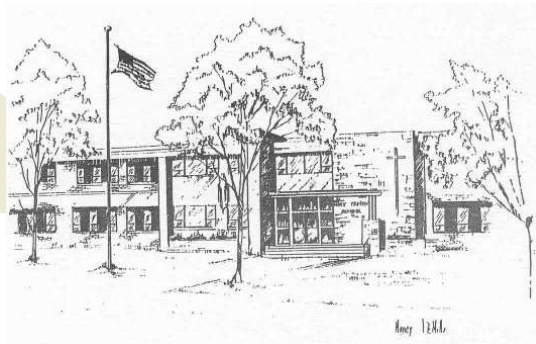
HFS Extended Day Program

HFS-EDP is designed to provide our students with an opportunity to extend the learning and engage in fun, informational, and enriching activities. We welcome all students with an interest in enrichment opportunities.

HFS-EDP is also designed to be a resource for parents who need help with their child between the end of the school day and the time they can pick up their child. We will provide a safe and enriching environment for your child!

Whether you want a place for your child to stay until the work day is over or you want your child to extend their learning day with enriching academics, HFS-EDP is the place!

Students will be instructed and cared for by a WI DPI certified lead teacher. All lesson plans and activities will be developed and implemented by the lead teacher. Student volunteers from local high schools may also be used as tutors during homework time. This allows students at the high schools to fulfill their required service time.

Holy Family School Extended Day Program

3:30-3:35 Arrival

Students arrive to the After-School Program and are greeted by the teachers. Students are encouraged to share their agendas/daily planners with the teachers.

3:35-3:50 Break/Snack Time

Students receive a nutritional snack and beverage.

3:50-4:30 Enrichment Academy Time (Math, Reading, Writing, Science) - (see next page)

4:30-5:25 Homework Time

Students will work on their homework and teachers will assist when needed. If a student does not have homework, they are encouraged to organize their folders/notebooks, study for upcoming quizzes/tests, silently read, work on class projects/reports, or play an educational game.

5:25-5:30 Dismissal

Students discuss strategies and goals with the teachers that they have worked on during their academy time and then get ready to go home.

Throughout the year, parents will receive:

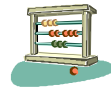
Monthly letters including goals, objectives, strategies, skills, and topics the students have been working on.

Progress reports will be sent home in January and June stating their child's progress within the program.

Early Dismissal days will have a different format and add in lunch and recreational activities outside or in the gym.

ENRICHMENT ACADEMIES

Academy time will be informational for students, but will also give them a chance to creatively explore different subjects—learning should be fun! The center is broken up into four Academies. The students will receive instruction in one of the Academies (Math, Reading, Writing, and Science) while Learning Strategies are implemented throughout. Lesson plans are designed to review material previously learned in the classroom and to develop skills utilizing strategies.



Mondays -Math Academy:

Through games and projects students will become stronger in their math skills and in turn gain a new appreciation for the subject—they will see how math is used in everyday life.



Tuesdays -Reading Academy:

Reading should be fun—students learn how to make reading easier and share the books that they have enjoyed with their classmates.



Wednesdays -Writing Academy:

Kids are authors too—students will write short stories, poetry, and work on other enjoyable writing projects that will foster creativity and imagination.



Thursdays -Science Academy: Can

a paper clip float in the air? Does sound travel through walls? What happens when food coloring is mixed with oil and water? The students will find out the answers to these questions along with the answers to many others.
