Dear Holy Family School Families,

Reminder: Tuition Agreement forms & Registration Fees were due by Friday, May 13. The registration fee is \$50.00 per child. If you paid a registration fee at the time of kindergarten enrollment earlier this year, please do not pay again for your 2005-06 kindergarten student. Tuition Assistance forms will be sent out within the next two weeks if you have requested one. Thank you for your patience!

NEW TSF TRACKING SYSTEM: In order to avoid tracking problems we will have a new system in place for next school year starting with the Fun Fest & Golf Outing. Chair persons for these events will have slips for volunteers to fill out. All volunteers will need to make sure their slips are filled out, signed by the chair/supervisor for the event, and keep these slips as proof of completion of hours. All families are responsible for keeping track of their own third source funding hours and handing them in by March 15, 2006. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. This new system should help alleviate any problems with tracking of TSF hours.

USED UNIFORM SALE: Mark your calendars! Thursday, June 2nd from 3:00 p.m.-5:30 p.m. the **USED UNIFORM SALE** will be held in the Social Hall of Holy Family School. All uniform items are to be cleaned, mended, and tagged (pinned), with the price tickets. Have your child drop off the uniform clothing in the social hall, on the morning of the day of the sale. The following day your money for sold items, and any items not sold, will be sent back home with your child. For those making purchases that day, please bring small bills and change to ease our checkout process.

BALANCES: We remind you that final report cards will be held until all tuition and third source balances are completed. Library fines, book fines, sports uniforms, band fees and hot lunch balances must be taken care of before final report cards can be issued. 2005 graduates must have all balances and parish financial commitments completed before a diploma can be given. If you have money left in your hot lunch account it will carry over to the next school year but we ask you to take care of any unpaid balances. Grade K-7 family parish financial responsibilities must be taken care of by the end of June for your 2005-2006 registration to be complete. Thank you.

Solo and ensemble, student council, service, and physical education awards will be given out at a special End of Year Assembly held in the gym at 8:30 am on June 8.
