2007-2008 Calendar: Our calendar is not finalized yet but we can share with you some of the dates for in-services and breaks. The first day of classes for all students will be Tuesday, September 4. Orientation Day will be Wednesday, August 29 from 6-8 p.m. with a New Family Orientation beforehand from 5:00-6:00 p.m. Mandatory Conferences are scheduled for October 24 & 25 with no school on October 26, 2007. Christmas Vacation begins with early dismissal on December 21st and runs through January 1st. Classes resume January 2, 2008. Diocesan In-Service will be held March 14. We will have an Easter Break next year from March 21 through March 28, 2008. Classes resume March 31, 2008. The last day of classes is June 4, 2008.
